    Test for url 'base:home'.
        Visit the url of name 'home' and check it loads the content

test_humans()
    Test for url 'base:base_files(humans.txt)'.
        Visit the url of humans.txt and check it loads the file

test_robots()
    Test for url 'base:base_files(robots.txt)'.
        Visit the url of robots.txt and check it loads the file
