
Eloquent JSON Schema Documentation

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1.1 Dependencies

- Laravel 5.x or Lumen
- JSON Schema

1- Require the package via Composer in your `composer.json`.

```
{
    "require": {
        "folklore/eloquent-json-schema": "~0.9.0"
    }
}
```

2- Run Composer to install or update the new requirement.

```
$ composer install
```

or

```
$ composer update
```

1.2 Laravel 5.5

1- Publish the configuration file

```
$ php artisan vendor:publish --provider=
↳ "Folklore\EloquentJsonSchema\JsonSchemaServiceProvider"
```

2- Review the configuration file

```
config/json-schema.php
```

1.3 Laravel <= 5.4.x

1- Add the service provider to your config/app.php file

```
Folklore\EloquentJsonSchema\JsonSchemaServiceProvider::class,
```

2- Publish the configuration file

```
$ php artisan vendor:publish --provider=  
↪ "Folklore\EloquentJsonSchema\JsonSchemaServiceProvider"
```

3- Review the configuration file

```
config/json-schema.php
```

1.4 Lumen

1- Load the service provider in bootstrap/app.php

```
$app->register(Folklore\EloquentJsonSchema\JsonSchemaServiceProvider::class);
```

2- Publish the configuration file

```
$ php artisan json-schema:publish
```

3- Load configuration file in bootstrap/app.php

Important: this command needs to be executed before the registration of the service provider

```
$app->configure('json-schema');  
...  
$app->register(Folklore\EloquentJsonSchema\JsonSchemaServiceProvider::class)
```

4- Review the configuration file

```
config/json-schema.php
```
