Q: What is husk? A: Husk is a programming language that uses Java/C-like syntax and some ideas from Haskell/Python to create a cleaner Java language.

Q: How do I write husk? A: Husk is written in lowercase whenever acceptable. However, it should be capitalized at the start of sentences and in acronyms. Basically, treat it like the word “husk.”
