1.1 Quickstart

Example:

```
$ curl http://scrapy.org/ | parsel-cli '.container a::attr(href)' | tail -2
http://doc.scrapy.org/en/latest/topics/ubuntu.html
https://github.com/scrapy/scrapy/archive/1.1.zip
```

Installation

2.1 Stable release

To install Parsel CLI, run this command in your terminal:

```
$ pip install parsel-cli
```

If you don't have `pip` installed, this [Python installation guide](#) can guide you through the process.

2.2 From sources

The sources for Parsel CLI can be downloaded from the [Github repo](#).

You can either clone the public repository:

```
$ git clone git://github.com/rolando/parsel-cli
```

Or download the [tarball](#):

```
$ curl -OL https://github.com/rolando/parsel-cli/tarball/master
```

Once you have a copy of the source, you can install it with:

```
$ pip install -e .
```
