
Springboard Documentation

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Springboard is a library and command line tool for scaffolding and bootstrapping sites for Universal Core.

Installation

```
pip install springboard
```

Starting a new site

First make sure you have [Elasticsearch](#) installed and running, then:

```
$ springboard startapp myapp
$ cd myapp
$ springboard import https://github.com/universalcore/unicore-cms-content-ffl-tanzania
$ pserve development.ini --reload

Starting server in PID 70411.
serving on http://0.0.0.0:6543
```

Now visit <http://0.0.0.0:6543/> in your browser and see the skeleton site with the content loaded from the repository.

The templates and the static files used to render and style the content are in the `myapp/templates` and `myapp/static` directories.
