Installation

This document describes the steps needed to set up woodstock in your own project.

You can also install woodstock using pip like so:

```
$ pip install woodstock
```

Or you can grab your own copy of the woodstock source from github:

```
$ git clone git://github.com/allink/woodstock.git
```

Make sure that woodstock and pennyblack are added to installed apps in the settings.py:

```
'woodstock',
'pennyblack',
```

To use south migrations specify a south migration module in the settings:

```
SOUTH_MIGRATION_MODULES = {
   'woodstock': 'project_name.migrations_woodstock',
}
```
