This project is developed by a few people. Like for every other php-script, this project requires some little experience. We provide a rudimentary setup-howto for some systems. For advance your installation for further purposes, please search for apache-, php- or mysql-howtos for the systemadministrator-work. We simply can't answer all sysadmin-related questions and a lot of topics are covered already out there.

If problems appear, consider read the troubleshoot-guide downer. In case it does not solve it, follow the guide to do a proper issue at github.

Our code support various systems and we have some howto's to setup a entire server as well. Mainly, we support and test Apache and Ubuntu (and Nginx for live-streamer-setup).

If you choose other systems, you propably need to know them and maybe some general . If you like to provide a howto, this is welcome!

CHAPTER 6

Performance

When you have a lot of users, your server can reach its limits. To prevent this, there are some things possible.

- Use a host with mysqlnd enabled! We provide support for non-mysqlnd-host's, but we have a SQL-cache for mysqlnd only. Also, this is a fast, native driver (better performance anyway). If you are unsure if you have this, ask your hoster.
- Enable minify of javascript! This helps only, to reduce the bandwidth a little. Go to advanced customization-plugin and enable "Minify JS". Clear videos/cache after this!
- Enable the [Cache-Plugin](#)
- Disable gifs(Gallery- and Youphpflix-plugin) or not set gifs (use less bandwidth)

CHAPTER 8

Troubleshooting

Various things can cause problems. Here, you find steps that eventually fix your problem. If it doesn't, please read [Check Ajax answer](#) and [How to find errors on YouPHPTube](#) for a usefull issue - this makes it easier for us to help you.

- Recheck, if all database-upgrades are done (**Menu -> Update version**)
- Clear the cache-folder (delete all files in **videos/cache/**)
- Ad-managment is broken? Try disable your adblocker
- Increase **default_socket_timeout** in **php.ini** (**default_socket_timeout=900** seems to do a good job)
- In case of changed **tmp**-directory, change it back to default
