### CHAPTER 1

Introduction

TimeClock<sup>1</sup> is a simple time clock reporting tool for the GNU/Emacs mode: timeclock. It's a command line tool that reads a timelog and prints a report to the console. By default the report looks something like this:

But it is also possible to generate a report formatted as HTML or CSV.

Installing TimeClock

TimeClock is written in Perl. If you already have Perl installed you can install TimeClock using CPAN:

\$ cpan App::TimeClock

## CHAPTER 3

### Configuration

If you haven't changed your GNU/Emacs setup, no configuration is needed. The script will read your timelog file from the default location which is  $\sim$ /.timelog

If you have changed the location of the timelog file (e.g placing it in a Dropbox folder), you can create the file  $\sim$ /. timeclockrc and define the location of the timelog file there. Example:

\$timelog = "\$ENV{HOME}/Dropbox/timelog";
