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Introduction

django-download_stats is an reusable application for Django framework , that allows users to download files and also create a download record.

Installation

Install django-download_stats by running:

```
startapp.sh django-download_stats
```

Running the tests

```
python setup.py test
```

django >= 1.4
```

1.1 Installation

pip install https://bitbucket.org/unh-gislab/download_stats_1.0/get/v1.0.zip

Source code can be downloaded from https://bitbucket.org/unh-gislab/download_stats_1.0

Run `startapp.sh download_stats` to start the app

1.2 Configuration

- Add to the `INSTALLED_APPS` in `settings.py`:

download_stats

Edit `config.py` and `setup.py` for more advanced configuration

How `django-download_stats` works

```
def download_file(request, filename=''):
    from .helpers import FileRegistry
    file_registry = FileRegistry()
    f = file_registry.get_file(request)
    if f.is_valid():
        return f.send_file()
    else:
        raise Http404
```
