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This is a Django application that adds management commands for managing your caches.

It provides these commands:

- `listcaches [names...]`

Lists the caches specified as arguments to the command.

Warning: This may expose SENSITIVE INFORMATION, like passwords.

Options:

- `--all`: List all the caches. Do not pass names when using this option.

- `pingcache [names...]`

Verifies that one or more caches are accessible (“pings” them).

Options:

- `--all`: Ping all the caches. Do not pass names when using this option.

- `clearcache [names...]`

Clears one or more caches.

- `--noop`: Do not actually perform the action. You can use this to test the arguments you are passing to the command.
- `--all`: Clear all the caches. Do not pass names when using this option.
- `--method=.`: The method to use to clear the cache.
 - * `conservative`: Remove only the keys that begin with the cache’s prefix. This is the default.
 - * `django-clear`: Use Django’s `clear` method, which will delete even keys that are not prefixed with the cache’s key.
