---

Dry ORM is inspired by Django-ORM.

Dryorm provides basic functionality on top of your models:

- Easily Instantiate objects mapping tables
- Get Instance by ID
- Update Instance on target database
- Follow instance changes to know what to save
- Avoid repeating code for fetching one/all elements

## 2.1 Using Pip

Run the command:

```
pip install dry-orm
```

## 2.2 Installing from the source

You can clone the repository and install:

```
git clone https://github.com/jalpedrinha/dryorm.git  
cd dryorm && python setup.py install
```
