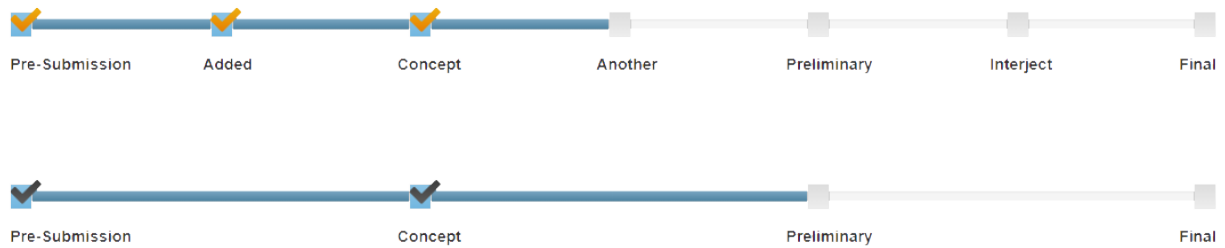

Milestones is a jQuery plugin that displays a timeline with milestones. The milestones are evenly separated along the timeline with labels underneath. Once a milestone is met, you can check it off and move to the next one.

CHAPTER 1

Background

Before we get to the code examples and how to include it in your html page, there's a couple of things to highlight first.

1.1 Requirements

Milestones is dependant on three external libraries which are listed below:

- Bootstrap
- jQuery
- Font-Awesome

CHAPTER 2

Getting Started

To begin, you need to ensure that the stylesheets and the javascript libraries are included in your html file.

2.1 Required Stylesheets

Load the required external Stylesheets:

```
<link rel="stylesheet" href="https://maxcdn.bootstrapcdn.com/bootstrap/3.3.7/
↪css/bootstrap.min.css">
<link rel="stylesheet" href="https://maxcdn.bootstrapcdn.com/font-awesome/4.7.
↪0/css/font-awesome.min.css">
<link rel="stylesheet" href="css/milestones.css">
```

2.2 Required Libraries

Include the required javascript libraries:

```
<script type="text/javascript" src="https://code.jquery.com/jquery-1.12.4.min.
↪js"></script>
<script type="text/javascript" src="https://maxcdn.bootstrapcdn.com/bootstrap/
↪3.3.7/js/bootstrap.min.js"></script>
<script type="text/javascript" src="js/milestones.js"></script>
```

2.3 Add a Container

Make sure you apply the *milestones* class and give the container an ID:

```
<div class="milestones" id="ms1"></div>
```

2.4 Instantiate the Plugin

This will apply default values and display the *milestones*.

```
<script>
  $(function(){
    $('#ms1').milestones();
  });
</script>
```

2.5 Add Options

This will control the labels, the progress and the checkmarks.

```
<script>
  $(function(){
    $('#ms1').milestones({
      position: 2, // progress to the 2nd milestone
      checks: 1, // apply a checkmark to the 1st milestone
      checkclass: 'ms-checkmark', // apply this class to the checkmarks
      msclass: 'doneclass', // apply this class to the completed tickmarks
      labels: ["Stage 1","Stage 2","Stage 3","Stage 4"] // array of labels
    });
  });
</script>
```
