Quick Start

`multidimensional_urlencode` lets you url encode a multidimensional dict:

```
>>> import urllib
>>> from multidimensional_urlencode import urlencode
>>> e = urlencode({"a": {"b": {"c": [1, 2, 3], "d": "e"}}})
>>> urllib.unquote(e)
'a[b][c][]=1&a[b][c][]=2&a[b][c][]=3&a[b][d]=e'
```

Development

Install requirements:

```
$ pip install -r requirements-dev.txt
```

Run tests:

```
$ py.test  
$ # or  
$ tox
```
