At the time of writing, ClickUp has the following limits in place for API requests:

- 100 requests per minute per token

## 1.1 Installation

```
# install pyclickup
pip install pyclickup
```

## 1.2 Basic Usage

```
from pyclickup import ClickUp

clickup = ClickUp('$ACCESS_TOKEN')

main_team = clickup.teams[0]
main_space = main_team.spaces[0]
members = main_space.members

main_project = main_space.projects[0]
```

```
