1.1 Installing pyeemd

The *pyeemd* module comes with a regular Python distutils installation script, so installing it should be quite straightforward. The only catch is that you need to first compile libeamd.so, since *pyeemd* is only a wrapper for that library. Please see the README file distributed with *libeamd* on more details on how to compile *libeamd*, but if you are unpatient and already have the necessary dependencies installed (GCC, GSL), you can just run make in the top-level directory of *libeamd* and you are done.

To install *pyeemd* please run:

```
python2 setup.py install
```

In the top-level directory of *pyeemd* (the one with setup.py).

If you want to specify an alternative installation prefix, you can do it as follows:

python2 setup.py install --prefix=\$HOME/usr
