Define three env vars WOD\_HOST, WOD\_USERNAME and WOD\_PASSWORD.

### 2.1 Testing

To check if your changes won't break anything test it:

```
composer install  
composer test # Runs all tests  
composer test-with-coverage # Runs all the tests and generates a code coverage report
```

### 2.2 Documentation

#### 2.2.1 API

The documentation of the API uses phpcoc. To update it run:

```
composer generate-documentation
```

**Note:** You need to [install phpcoc](#).

### 2.3 Coding Standard

This library uses the [Symfony Coding Standard](#).

To apply all the rules automatically:

```
composer fix-code-styling
```

**Note:** You need [PHP Coding Standards Fixer](#) for this.
